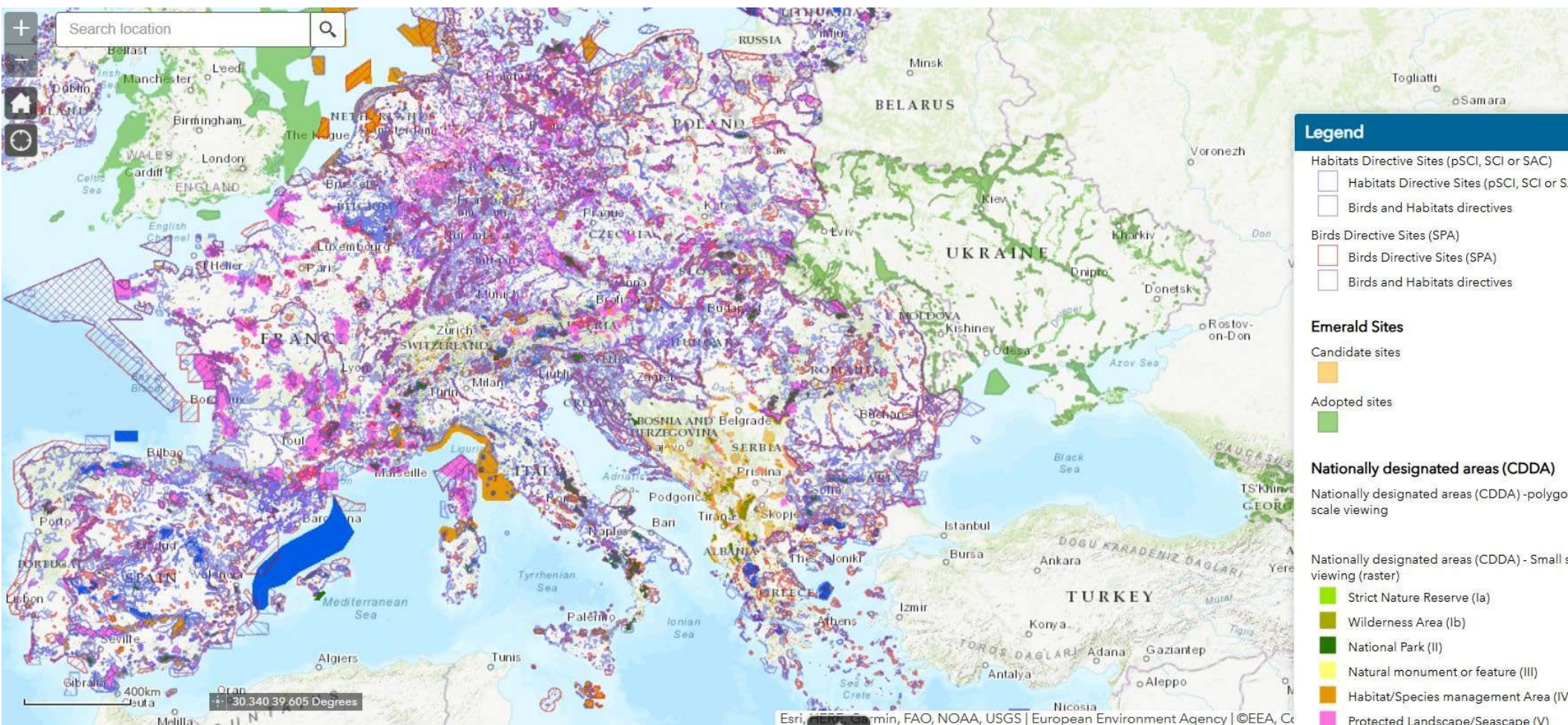

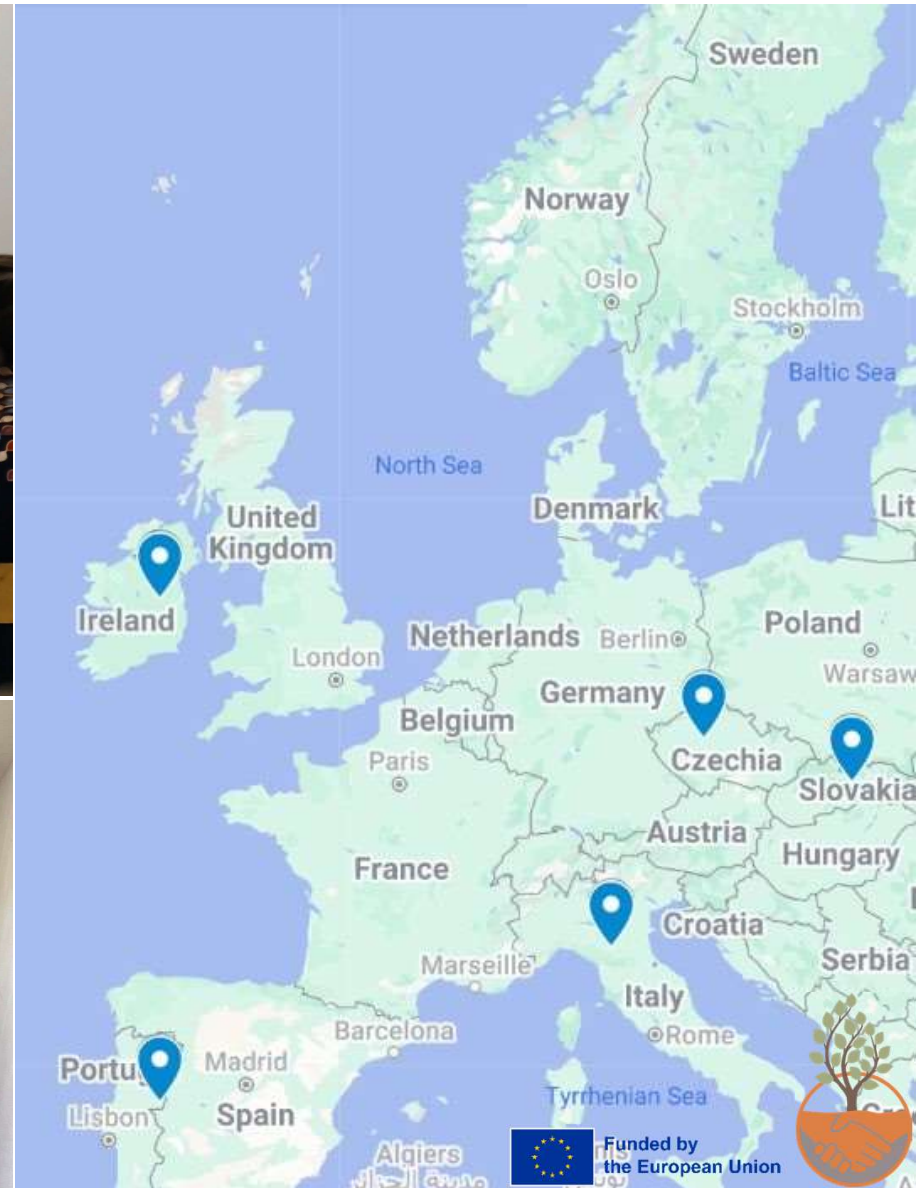

Legal opposition

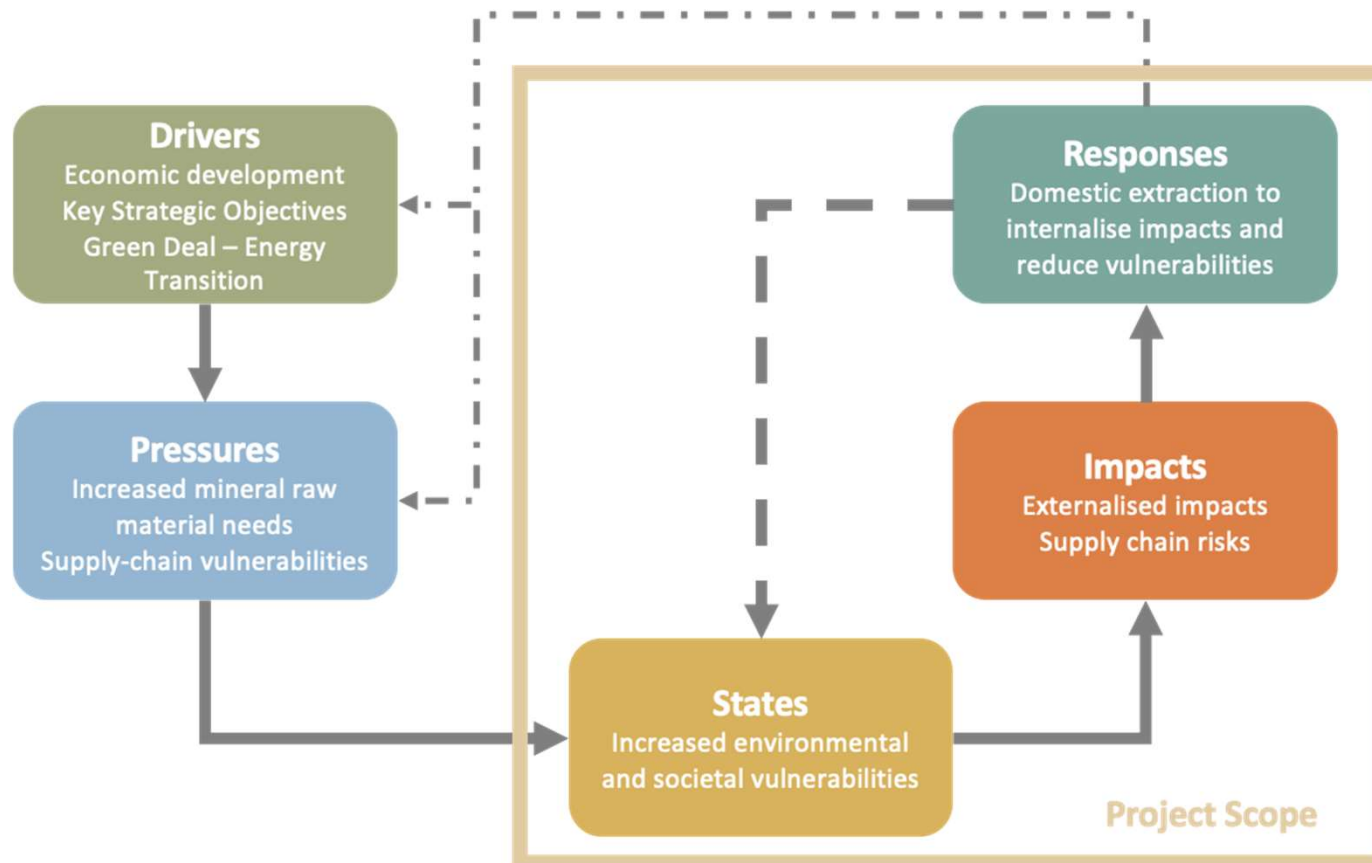
Overriding public interest would solve a number of those issues.

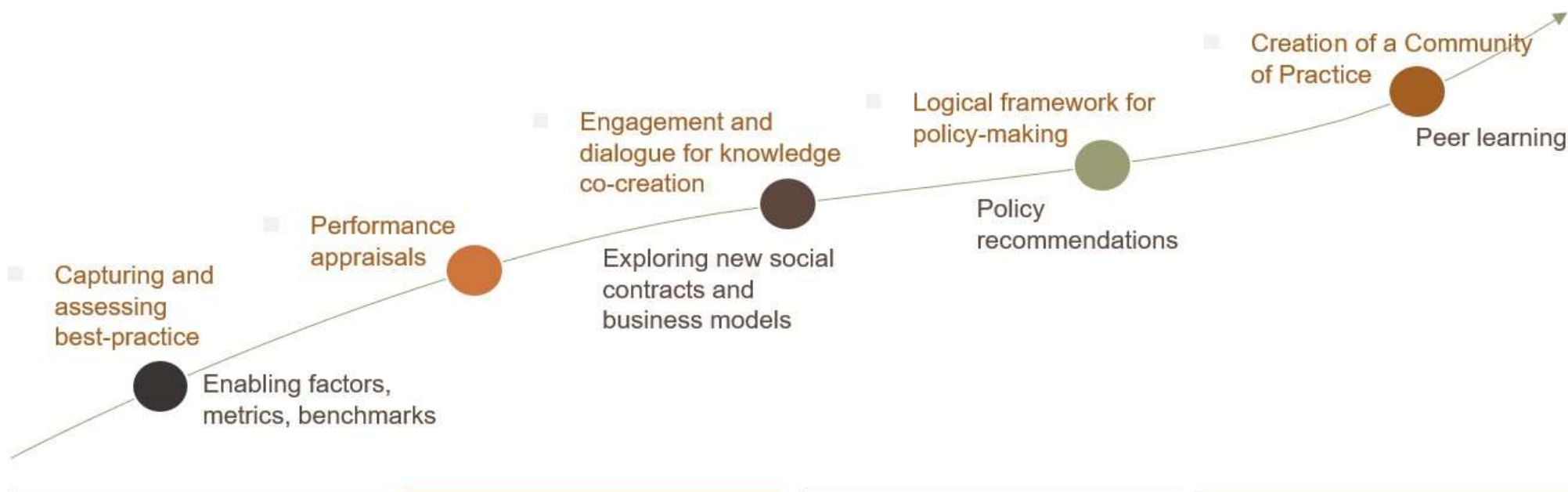

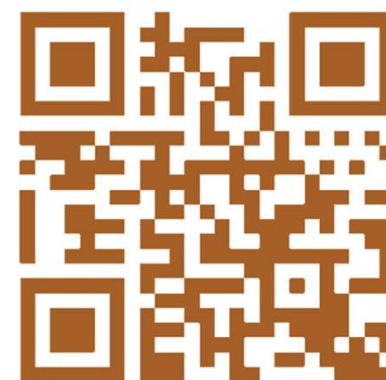
